FROM GLOBALIZATION TO REGIONALIZATION AND LOCALIZATION: INSTITUTIONS, PROCESSES, POLICIES, AND STRATEGIES

OBJECTIVES

The 26th World Business Congress of the International Management Development Association (IMDA) will be held in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, between May 19-23, 2017. The major local organizer is Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University, Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences and in cooperation with private and public sector partners from Kyrgyzstan. Full and research-in-progress papers, panel session proposals, and case study presentations are invited and accepted papers will be published in the award winning refereed congress proceedings. Full papers included in the congress proceedings are published in Web of Science, Social Sciences Citation Index which is afforded only to a small number of congress proceedings around the globe. The Best Papers of the congress will be published in the Journal of Transnational Management and/or Journal of Euromarketing and outstanding papers will be considered for other journal publications. The congress offers an excellent opportunity to meet international thought leaders and professionals from around the world to exchange information and ideas on a variety of global business topics.

VENUE

Kyrgyz Republic is a country in Central Asia, the territory of which is located within two mountain ranges the Pamir-Altai in the southwest and the Tien Shan Mountains in the northeast. The total area of Kyrgyz Republic is 198,500 sq. km. surface waters occupy 4.4% of the territory, 5.5% forest, 54.1% agricultural land, and the remaining 36.2% other forms. Kyrgyz Republic covers an area of 3,878 km borders with Kazakhstan in the north, with China to the east and southwest, with Uzbekistan to the west, and to the southeast with Tajikistan. Many travelers find Kyrgyz Republic the most appealing, accessible and welcoming of the Central Asian republics, one expert called the country as Switzerland of central Asia. Known as Frunze from 1926 to 1991, Bishkek is the capital of Kyrgyz Republic, and the largest city of the country. Besides, the city is the administrative center of the Chui region with population of over 1 million. It was founded in 1825, and was named Pishpek. It is the only town in the world named after a wooden plunger- a Bishkek is a churn used to make fermented mare's milk. The capital is planned like a chess board, and on both sides of most streets there are ditches for watering trees. Trees are watered in this way in the summertime not only save people from the heat but also decorate the city. The city center, avenues and roads are flat and constructed in a proper way. Bishkek is a beautiful city with many parks and green plantations. Residents like to boast that it has more trees per person. Bishkek, which is a comparatively new city in Chui valley, has no historical monuments from ancient times, but in the largest square of the city there is a historical museum. In the very center of the city there is an entertainment park named after I. V. Panfilov.

CONGRESS PROGRAM AND EXTRA EXCURSION OPTIONS

This year's congress focuses on globalization, regionalization, and localization and will offer keynote addresses by business leaders, academic and case study presentations, expert panel discussions will provide insight into the most relevant issues and developments in today's global business environment. To celebrate the congress, a banquet dinner along with award ceremony will be held in the evening of May 21st, 2017. Business people, public policy makers, consultants and academics can choose from the wide range of topics within the overall congress theme. An important aspect of the congress will be the Bishkek city tour. Bishkekcapital of Kyrgyzstan situated in the Chui valley at the northern foot of the republic. It is at an altitude of 700-900 meters above sea level. Bishkek has a population of about 1 million. During the city tour you can admire the Soviet architecture such as Philharmonic-Concert Hall, Government House, the Historical Museum, Victory Square as well as modern monuments made in national style such as the White House, the Museum of Applied Art, the Manas Village, Panfilov Park on May 19th, 2017. There are available additional tours on May 22, 2017 Ala-Archa Gorge Kyrgyz State Nature Park. It is located 40 km away from Bishkek at the foot of the mountain range Ala-Too, at an altitude of 1600-4860 meters. In the park, you will have the opportunity to climb the canyons, which are located at an altitude of 5,000 meters above sea level. Each climbing requires special training. The park has a unique opportunity to meet representatives of fauna such as the eagle, mountain goat, wolf, lynx, and a rarely seen snow leopard. These tours are complimentary. We are also organizing paid post-congress tours to Almaty, Kazakhstan and Samarkand and Bukhara, Uzbekistan. More detail information will be provided about the post-congress tours in mid-March 2017.

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INSTRUCTIONS AND DATES

Three types of papers are acceptable for consideration: refereed, work-in-progress, and special session/panel papers. There will be a doctoral research symposium in the afternoon of Saturday, May 20, 2017, for which we only require a five-page abstract. Doctoral research symposium proposals must be submitted to Dr. Barry Unger at Boston University, E-mail: unger@bu.edu by April 30th, 2017. All other submissions must adhere to the following guidelines:

- If you wish to have your paper reviewed for the award winning refereed Congress proceedings, submit an electronic copy of your complete manuscript, not exceeding 25 pages double and 8 pages single-spaced, to only one track chair on or before March 15, 2017, though earlier submissions are strongly encouraged. Please cc your submission to Dr. Talha D. Harcar Congress Administrative Director in the United States at tdh13@psu.edu
- Papers will be reviewed and final decisions will be communicated no later than April 14, 2017. Revisions should be expected. Final manuscripts, in required format with changes consistent with requested revisions, must be received by Dr. Talha D. Harcar by May 1, 2017 at the latest. If submitted late or published guidelines are not followed, submission cannot be included in the congress proceedings.
- Submit an electronic copy of an abstract of works in-progress of one page by March 31, 2017. These documents will be published in the congress proceedings provided that style guidelines are followed and references provided. They will also be included in the Congress program. Submit your appropriate congress registration fee and completed registration form along with the abstract. Abstracts must be submitted either to Dr. Erdener Kaynak at kgy@psu.edu or to Dr. Talha D. Harcar at tdh13@psu.edu
- Receipt of all electronic submissions will be acknowledged as soon as received. If you do not hear from the track chair within one week of your paper submission, please contact Dr. Talha D. Harcar at once via tdh13@psu.edu. On a separate page, please provide the title of your paper, your full address, telephone and e mail numbers clearly written. If there are multiple authors, this information is to be provided by all authors. We will include this information in IMDA data bank and you will also receive complimentary copies of one of the Association's quarterly Journals- Journal of Transnational Management or Journal of Euromarketing.
- Complete the attached congress registration form and send it to the Executive Vice-President and Director in Pennsylvania, USA address as soon as possible no later than April 14, 2017. If your paper is not accepted either for presentation or publication in the congress proceedings, your registration fee will be refunded to you immediately.
- Each registered delegate is entitled to have a maximum of two accepted manuscripts included in the Congress proceedings and/or program. In the event of more than two papers being accepted, the participant must inform Dr. Talha D Harcar of the titles of the two papers to be included in the proceedings or program. Otherwise, the selection decision will be made by the Congress organizers.
- Manuscript submissions should include a separate title page on each copy, listing all authors, their affiliations, addresses, telephone numbers and e mail addresses, if available. For papers with multiple authors, indicate the author with whom we should correspond. List only the manuscript title in the main body of the paper, abstract, or proposal to allow for blind review.
- The final copy of manuscripts to be published in the Congress proceedings may not exceed 8 pages, single-spaced, 10-point font, including tables, figures, and references. All of the references cited in the body of the paper must be presented under references at the end of the paper. There will be an extra page charge of US\$25 per page which must be sent along with the final camera-ready version of the manuscript. There are no exceptions to this rule. Manuscripts that do not conform to the guidelines or do not include extra-page charges where applicable will not be published. In the counting of the number of pages, IMDA executives make use of 8 ½ by 11 page size, not that of A4 size.
- International Management Development Association is a not-for-profit professional organization. As such, it does not provide any funding for
 travel, accommodation, and congress registration. Such requests will not be responded. The Association can only provide visa support letters
 to those individuals whose papers are accepted and included in the Congress program and they should pay the appropriate congress registration
 fees in advance. All other requests are not acceptable.

SPECIAL SESSIONS AND PANELS

Proposals for special sessions and/or panels are invited and must include: a) a short summary of the issues to be discussed, b) rationale for inclusion of the topic in a special session/panel, c) names, addresses, and qualifications of participants, and d) a letter indicating that session/panel participants' approval has been obtained. Special session/panel presentation papers will not be published in the congress proceedings unless they go through the usual blind review process. TRAVEL TIPS

There are direct flights to Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan from Turkey, Russian Federation, Kazakhistan, the PRC, Dubai, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan. Manas International Airport is the main entry point in Kyrgyzstan located 25 kms (16 miles) northwest of the capital Bishkek. Today the airport makes 17 regular flights including 4 domestic and 13 international. The partners of the airport are the largest airlines of Russia and the other foreign countries which connect Bishkek with hundreds of cities around the world. Turkish Airlines is the major carrier linking Bishkek to outside world.

Many private taxi services are available at the airport. You are expected to book by going on their websites or by calling. It takes 40-45 minutes from Manas International Airport to Bishkek town center and to your selected hotel site by taxi and will cost about 600-700 som (approximately \$10). The number 380 minibus also offer cheaper service (50 som-less than \$1) to Bishkek leaving every 30 minutes but these buses will take much longer. KYRGYZSTAN VISA REQUIREMENTS

1. Citizens of the countries listed below intending to visit Kyrgyzstan for duration up to 60 days* are exempt from the visa:



^{*}A visa is required for above mentioned nationals intending to stay in Kyrgyzstan more than 60 days.

 - a. An invitation letter.
 - b. Authorization letter for visa from the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Kyrgyzstan ("visa support"). Inviting person or organization in Kyrgyzstan shall contact the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs not less than 30 days before submitting the application for visa at the Embassy. We strongly advise you not to confirm your travel arrangements until you have received this "visa support" for your visa application.
